Short Summary:

This file is a template of a chapter proposal for Protostars and Planets VII. The proposal should be no more than **4 pages** including figures and tables but excluding references. You may adjust some cosmetics like margins, but **do not change the page size (a4paper) and font size (11pt)**. The proposal should be submitted as a single **PDF** file, and its size should not exceed **5MB**. Submission is now open through the conference website <<http://ppvii.org/>> until **April 1st, 2020**.

In PPVII, **one author can contribute to only one proposal per person, either as the first author or as a co-author**. In addition, our goal is that each chapter should not be a loosely connected collection of subsections written by individuals, but a comprehensive and coherent review story. Therefore, a proposal with too many co-authors is not recommended. **Proposals with 3-6 authors that provide a broad perspective are encouraged.**

We are looking forward to reading excellent proposals and seeing you in Kyoto. If we are lucky, cherry blossom will be in full bloom.
